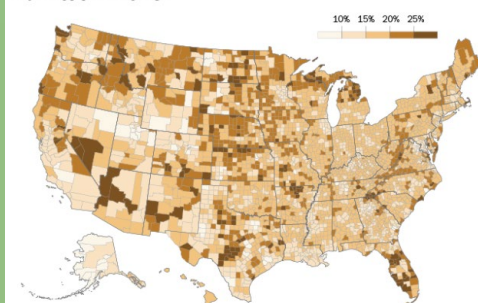

Counties With the Largest, Smallest Shares of Seniors

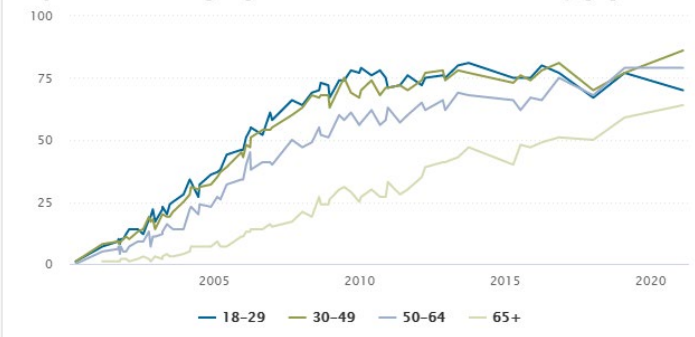
% of county population ages 65+

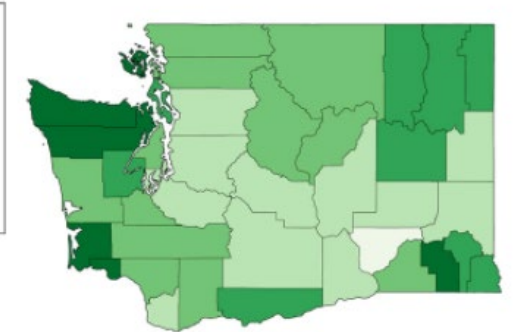
Who has home broadband?
