3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lifespan Respite Care  
5 Reauthorization Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF LIFESPAN RESPITE CARE**  
7 **PROGRAM.**

8 (a) DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.—Section  
9 2904 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–  
10 3) is amended to read as follows:

1 **“SEC. 2904. DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.**

2 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Each State agency awarded a  
3 grant or cooperative agreement under section 2902 shall  
4 report such data, information, and metrics as the Sec-  
5 retary may require for purposes of—

6 “(1) evaluating State programs and activities  
7 funded pursuant to such grant or cooperative agree-  
8 ment, including any results pursuant to section  
9 2902(d)(2)(B)(xii); and

10 “(2) identifying effective programs and activi-  
11 ties funded pursuant to section 2902.

12 “(b) REPORT.—Not later than October 1, 2023, the  
13 Secretary shall submit a report to the Committee on  
14 Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate and  
15 the Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House  
16 of Representatives regarding the outcomes of the pro-  
17 grams and activities funded pursuant to section 2902, in-  
18 cluding any effective programs and activities identified.”.

19 (b) FUNDING.—Section 2905 of the Public Health  
20 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–4) is amended by striking  
21 “title” and all that follows through the period and insert-  
22 ing “title, \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020  
23 through fiscal year 2024.”.
