

TRIZ: Best Practices in UN-Sustainability (2:00-2:45 PM)

1. **(3 minutes)** Working alone,
 - identify the most critical aspect of your LR program or grant (such as the coalition, voucher program, etc.) that needs to be sustained beyond the LR Grant Cycle.
 - In column A, list of all you can do to make sure that what you have identified as most critical is **NOT SUSTAINED**

2. **(9 minutes)** Find a partner (a person from your state would be best.) Go down your lists and identify what you are currently doing that in any way, shape, or form resembles the items you listed. Put this list in column B. Be brutally honest as you make the second list of all your counterproductive activities/programs/procedures.

3. **(15 minutes)** Join others to form a group of no more than 6, discuss the items in the B column and discuss steps for stopping undesirable results.
