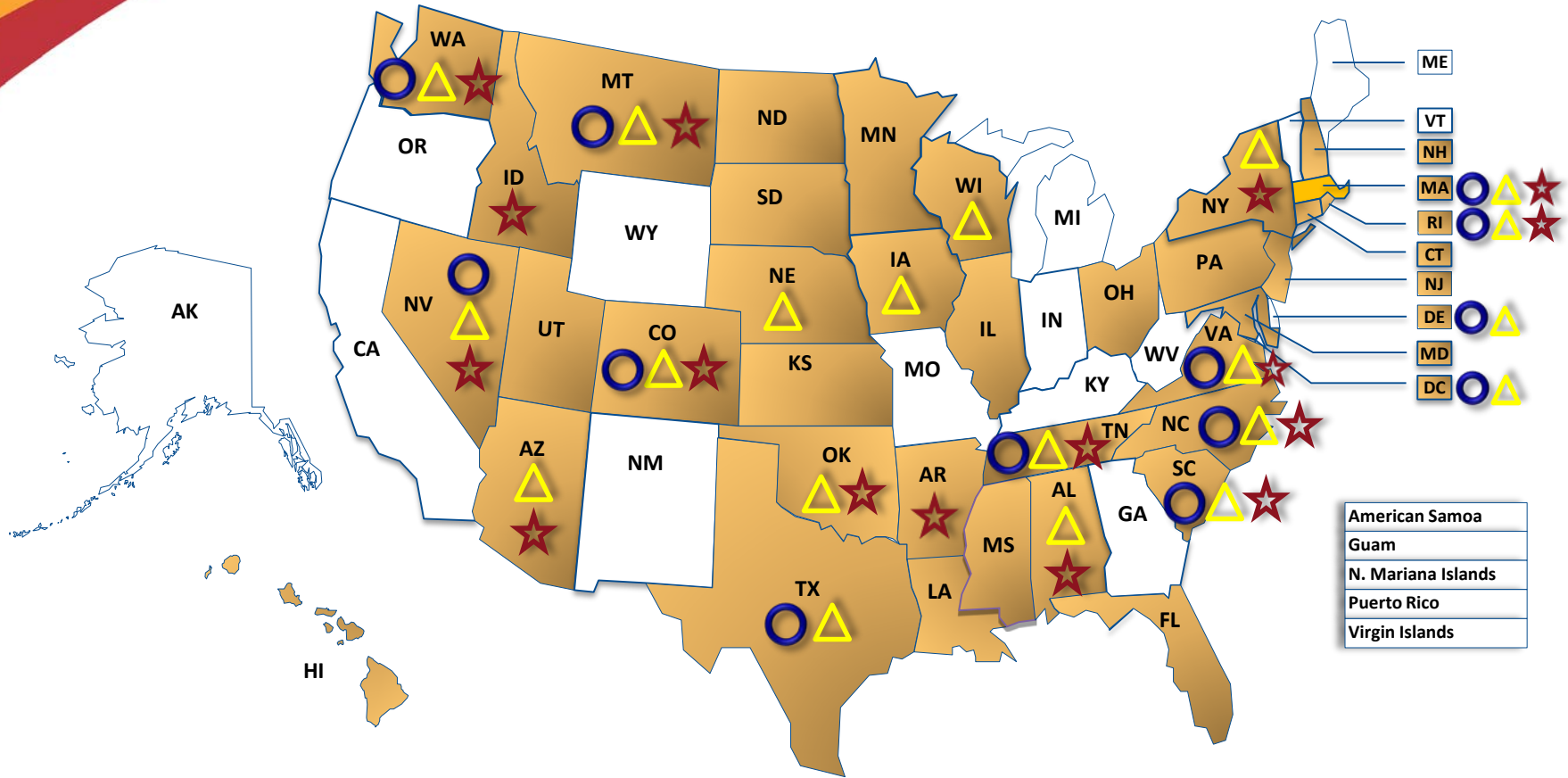

# Lifespan Respite States Awarded as of 2019

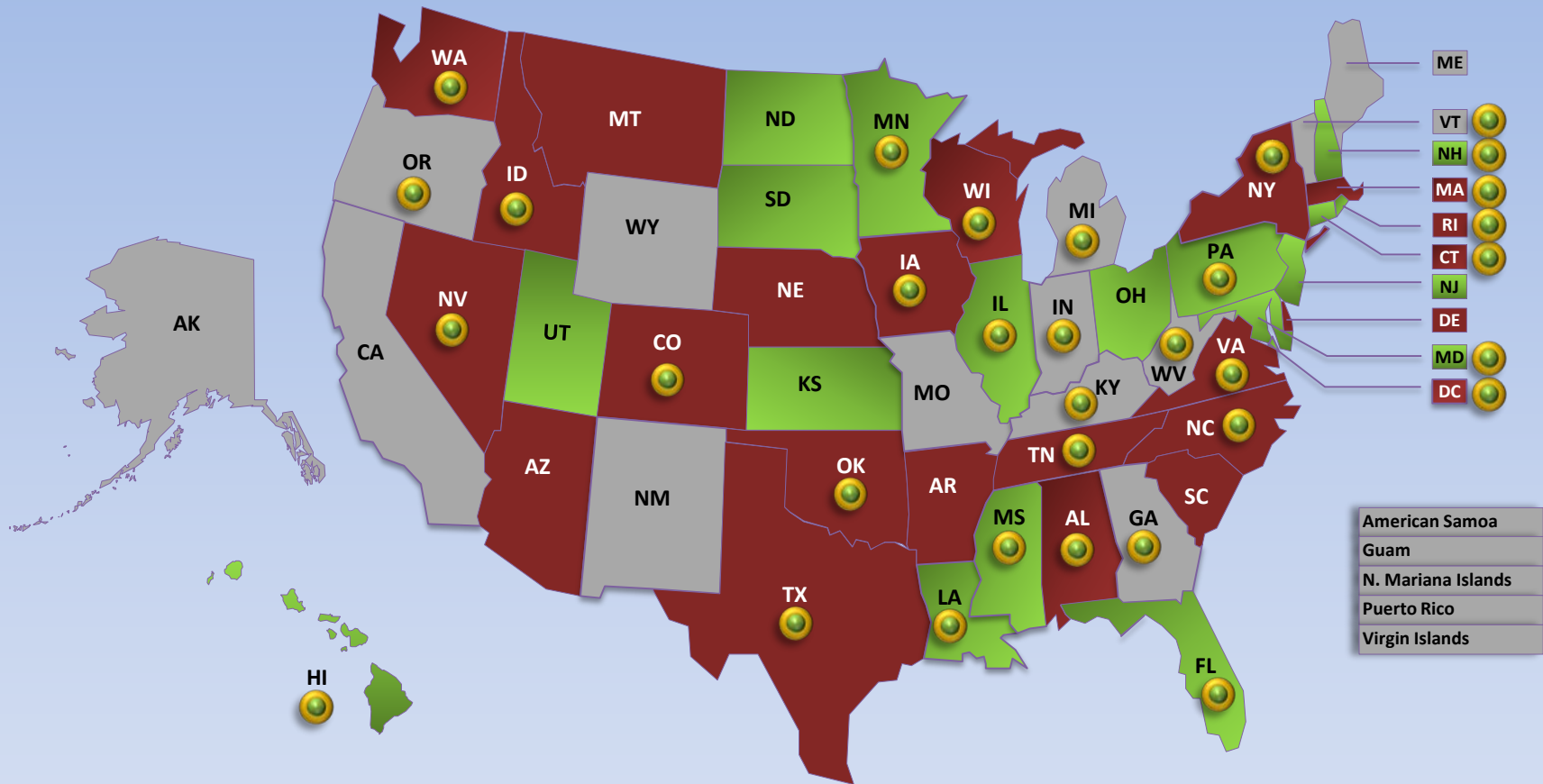
