RCAW's **Respite Care Certificate Program (RCCP)** is a core curriculum training program for people who are interested in providing respite care to individuals with varying disabilities and ages across the lifespan. Learners can work at their own pace to complete the required online courses.

### The Brag – Unique Collaboration!

- RCAW will provide a branch in our web-based training platform for South Carolina Respite Coalition (SCRC) to house online training courses.
- RCAW will provide clones of the RCCP universal training components (they can still modify) and templates for SCRC to create their own state specific curriculum.
- The training include slides, information, videos, pre/ post-tests, surveys, and certificates.
- SCRC will have access to any additional online courses developed by RCAW.
- SCRC will have access to reports on their courses, users, tests, assignments, surveys, discussion boards, etc. that are housed in their branch.
- SCRC will share any courses developed with RCAW to use/ modify to offer to RCAW users.
- ***RCAW is open to collaborating with any other state Lifespan Respite Grantees.***

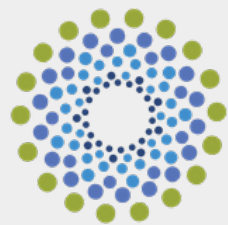

- RCAW 's **Mini-Grant** is a small grant, up to \$3,000 to support eligible applicants with outreach, education, worker recruitment, and training assistance through a one-day event.
- Both the successful applicant and RCAW will have a set of responsibilities and will work together to achieve the goals of the mini-grant, which are to:
  - expand the pool of trained respite care workers,
  - educate local family caregivers,
  - bring together local agencies that support family caregivers,
  - help connect respite care workers with family caregivers and respite care provider agencies.

RCAW' recently created and implemented a new **Meaningful Activities Program** developed to support trained workers listed on our registry by offering a FREE meaningful activities that they can do with care recipients across the lifespan.

We ask that they keep in mind the likes and preferences of the respite care recipient, making it person-centered for them. They have the option to choose one activity from a list of eight options.

RCAW will also provide PPE in efforts to minimize the spread of COVID-19.

All we ask in return is they take a photo while enjoying the activity with the care recipient, and provide a short write-up on how it enriched the care recipient's life.
